I am delighted to report that Beta DKE is in excellent shape with a terrific group of actives, active and supportive alumni, and excellent staff. Likewise, the house is in great shape.

Leadership is strong. **Russell Hardin** (Bro Beta for 2011-12) leaves the house well-positioned for newly elected **Stephen Stephano**. Last fall, we secured the best pledge class on campus—initiating 18 new active brothers on February 15th. Bill Schmidt '66 Named 2012 Distinguished Alumni Award Winner

Former Chapter President Helped with the House Rebuilding Project

Every year, the Alumni Board of Directors of Beta DKE chooses an alumnus worthy of the 1851 Distinguished Alumni Award. The award goes to an alumnus who has, over an extended period of time, shown extraordinary interest, love, and dedication to the DKE house.

William "Bill" Schmidt '66 was chosen by the Alumni Board of Directors as such a man previously described. The love, time, and dedication that Bill has given to the DKE house at UNC can only be matched by the few who have also won the award. Bill said that he was "surprised and very excited to receive the award... to be mentioned among such predecessors who I knew very well."

Bill's Deke memories began in 1962 on a Sunday night during rush when he met **Surry Roberts '62**. Surry told Bill about "all the great things about being a Deke." Obviously, something Surry told Bill stuck because Bill would go on to do "all the great things about being a Deke." Bill would soon be the president of the DKE Beta Chapter from 1965-1966.

Many of the great memories and traditions Bill and Surry talked about are still among the great Deke traditions carried out here today. The great, big parties of the DKE basement (minus the jukebox), having "Doug Clark and the Hot Nuts" play on parents weekend and any other chance possible, and living in the DKE house with all his best friends are traditions that have stayed strong since Bill's departure from UNC.

The DKE house standing today was, in part, built due to the dedication and commitment Bill has shown to the Beta Chapter. **Mike Hoyt '66**, one of Bill's closest friends throughout his life, called him and asked him to be the Alumni President in 1985. Bill graciously accepted and, while president from 1985-1987, started the restoration campaign to rebuild the house. Bill's pledge class, Class of 1966, was one of the most generous classes in fundraising when rebuilding the house, which included **Mike Hoyt**, who also received the 1851 Award in 2008.

Bill is now one of the few alumni who have received the 1851 Distinguished Alumni Award and one the few who know what it means to give back the time and love that was once shown to them. Bill will be remembered not only because his name is written on the 1851 Award plaque in the chapter room of the DKE house but, more importantly, because of the outstanding dedication and time he gave to the DKE house at UNC.




