# Beta DKE 2013-14 Active Brothers Are Scholars and Gentleman — Maintain Good Grades and Make Alumni Proud

The 2013-14 school year has been one of hard work and continuous improvement at the DKE house at UNC. The active brothers worked hard academically and supported a number of philanthropic initiatives this year. (See Ward Wood's article on page 4). The alumni investment of time, talent and treasure is seeing dividends.

The active brothers have been "hitting the

books" extremely hard. For fall semester 2013 DKE had a house average GPA of 3.194. (For context, the UNC all-men average GPA was a 3.236 and the all-university average was 3.207, which includes women. The women's all-university average was 3.268, and the all-sorority average was 3.336.)

We are also proud to report we have 8 active brothers with GPAs of 3.750 or higher, 4 active brothers who received "comeback" awards for achieving jumps in their GPAs of at least .5 points between Spring 2013

and Fall 2013. Congratulations to these men for representing DKE well! Their collective efforts truly represent those of "a scholar, a gentleman, and a jolly good fellow."

Now that we have surpassed the 3.0 GPA fixed goal, we will continue with rush activities.

#### Physical Plant Updates Keep Beta Competitive

The alumni have been hard at work updating the physical plant. A big thank you everyone who has been involved. The updates include installing wireless Internet access throughout the house, which was needed to support the increased utilization, with more and more guys studying at the house. Several other fraternities

on campus have been spending quite a bit updating their facilities, so we need to continually improve our physical plant every year, in order to keep the DKE house the best looking, and functioning, on campus.


#### **Remaining Wish List**

than 7 other fraternities combined.


